Director, Stephenson Cancer Center; Interim Chair, Radiation Oncology; Professor, Department of Obstetrics and Gynecology, University of Oklahoma College of Medicine

Dr. Mannel is a leader in the National Clinical Trials Network of the National Cancer Institute, and his clinical and research interests include laparoscopy for gynecologic malignancies, gynecologic oncology, and drug development for ovarian, endometrial, and cervical cancers.

Dr. Mannel has published over 100 scientific articles dealing with the management of gynecologic malignancies and is currently a Co-Editor of *Clinical Gynecologic Oncology*, one of the major textbooks in its field. Dr. Mannel has served in multiple national leadership positions in his field, including serving as a committee member of the Gynecologic Oncology Board of the American Board of Obstetrics and Gynecology and as Vice President of the Society of Gynecologic Oncology in 2012–2013. Dr. Mannel completed medical school at the University of Texas Medical Branch at Galveston, his residency at Baylor Scott & White Medical Center, and a fellowship at the University of California, Irvine.
