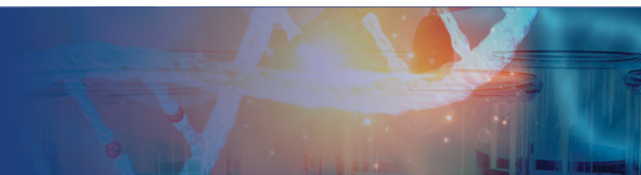

Dr. Brewster is a Co-Investigator for several projects designed to identify populations at risk for disparate treatment and poor outcomes in endometrial, colon, ovarian and cervical cancers. After completing her residency in obstetrics and gynecology at the University of California, Los Angeles, Dr. Brewster completed her fellowship at the University of California, Irvine in gynecologic oncology.



At UC Irvine, Dr. Brewster completed a doctorate in epidemiology and contributed to epidemiologic studies focused on improving how people receive cancer care. Since that time, Dr. Brewster has practiced medicine and conducted research to identify populations at risk for disparate treatment and poor outcomes in endometrial, colon, ovarian, and cervical cancers. She was appointed Director of the UC Irvine Gynecologic Oncology Fellowship in 2007.

The following year, Dr. Brewster moved to North Carolina to provide a larger impact and extend her reach to disciplines outside of oncology. Dr. Brewster continues to maintain a busy clinic schedule in the UNC Department of Obstetrics and Gynecology's Division of Gynecologic Oncology while serving as CWHR's Director. She also enjoys serving as a mentor to other gynecologic oncologists and collaborating on various projects.
